August 3<sup>rd</sup> has been designated as the date for this year's National Night Out. Beverly Hills residents are encouraged to plan as many outdoor activities as possible on this day. NNO 2009 involved over 36 million people in 14,625 communities from all 50 states, U.S. territories, Canadian cities, and military bases worldwide.
